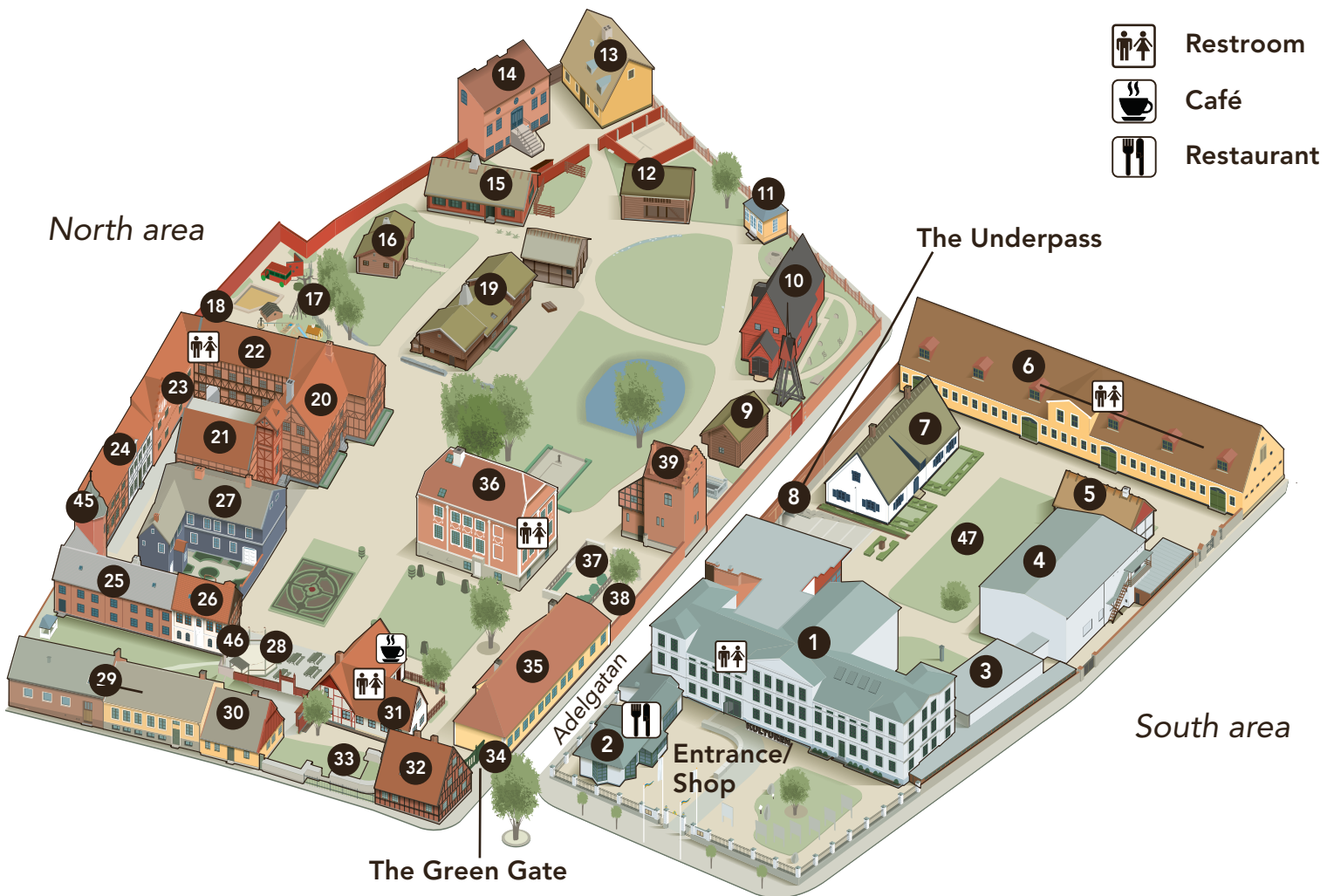


Kulturen in Lund is a museum stretching over two blocks, the North and South area. These are linked by the Underpass (No. 8). If you can't use the tunnel staircase, you can reach the North area via the Green Gate (No. 34), ask for a code in the shop. If you need help, call +46 46-35 04 01.

NOTE: Children must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Please do not sit on the furniture or touch the objects on display in our historic buildings and exhibitions. Children are welcome to play in the playground (No.17) and play exhibition (No. 6).
