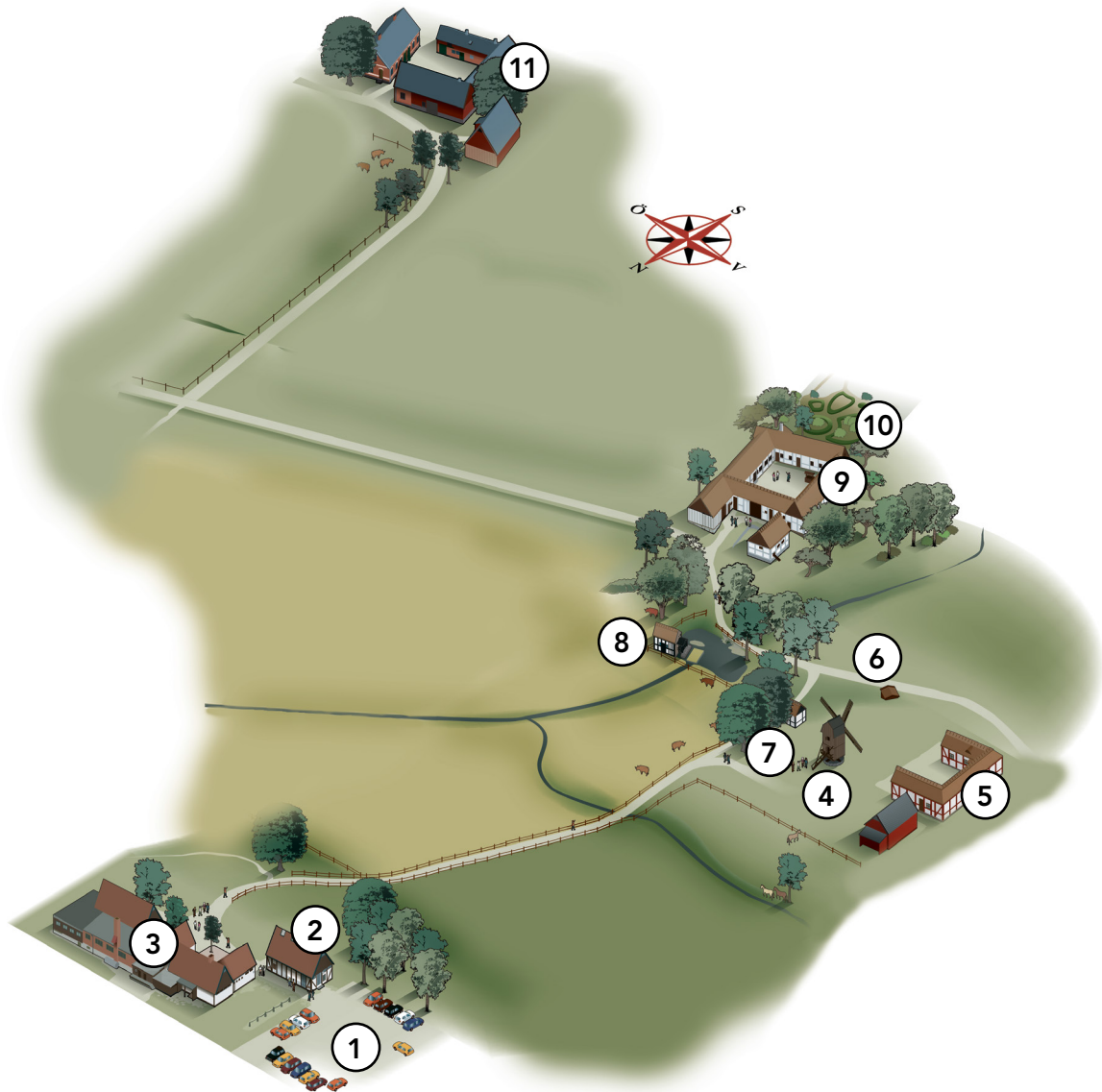


Welcome to Kulturen's Östarp!



- 1. Parking**
- 2. The Östarp Hall**
Information point & maps
- 3. Östarps Gästgivaregård (restaurant)**
- 4. The Windmill**
Used to grind grain.
- 5. Möllegården**
Built in 1924. Not open to visitors.
- 6. Flax shed**
Used to prepare flax for the production of linen. Temporarily closed for restoration.
- 7. The Malthouse**
Used to make malt for brewing beer.
- 8. The Watermill**
Mill and mill pond used to grind grain.
- 9. Gamlegård**
A timber-framed farmstead built in the 1810s. Open to visitors during the summer season (see signs for opening times).
- 10. Gamlegård's garden**
A horticultural legacy from the end of the 1800s.
- 11. Brödragården**
An early 1900s farmstead. We have started a restoration, and will have some guided tours of the farmstead this year.
